



Recommended Health Program For Your Kitten

At Pets and Vets as Partners we recommend starting the vaccination program at 6-8 weeks of age and continuing until 17-19 weeks.

6-8 weeks old (total \$149.42)

13-15 weeks old (four weeks after second visit) (total \$92.18)

17-19 weeks old (four weeks after third visit) (total \$49.46)

After the recommended vaccination program is complete, your kitten will only need booster vaccines once yearly. We advise that a fecal analysis be done twice a year to check for internal parasites.
