Late Fall/Winter Care Tips:

Most pets suffer from dry skin during the winter months, due to the dryness from heat in your home. You can help this by supplementing Omega 3 Fatty Acids to your pets diet. The fatty acids will work on your pets skin to keep in the oils to prevent dryness. Ask about this!

Easy treats for your pet & nutritional!

Try to make a homeade treat for your pet that is good for them too!

1. Dry food – grind kibbles into flour by using a blender and mix with enough water to form a dough. Shape into “cookies” and bake on a cookie sheet in oven for approx. 30 min. at 350 or until crispy.

2. Canned food – cut up bite sized pieces or slice a section and bake on a cookie sheet in oven for approx. 30 min. at 350 or until desired texture is desired.

** Store in refrigerator, no longer than 5-7 days.
